6th Sino-German Agricultural Week

30 November to 3 December 2020

Beijing, Huairou, Yanqi Lake

In the context of the bilateral cooperation between the German Federal Ministry for Food and Agriculture (BMEL) and the Chinese Ministry for Agriculture and Rural Affairs (MARA) the 6th Sino-German Agricultural Week will be held from 30 November to 3 December 2020. The week is jointly sponsored by MARA and BMEL, implemented by the Sino-German Agricultural Centre (DCZ).

Due to the international travel limitations caused by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic this year' s conference will be organized as a hybrid event of on-site conferences and online webinars. The on-site conference will be held in the Swan Lake View Hotel 北京中建雁栖湖景酒店 at Yanqi Lake, Huairou District in Beijing. For participants who will not be able to attend in Beijing it will be possible to attend the conference via online streaming.

High-level representatives from politics, science and agribusiness of both countries are expected to participate and contribute in-person or online. For three days leading researchers, policy makers and entrepreneurs will share research findings, practical experiences and insights on the latest developments in the respective fields. 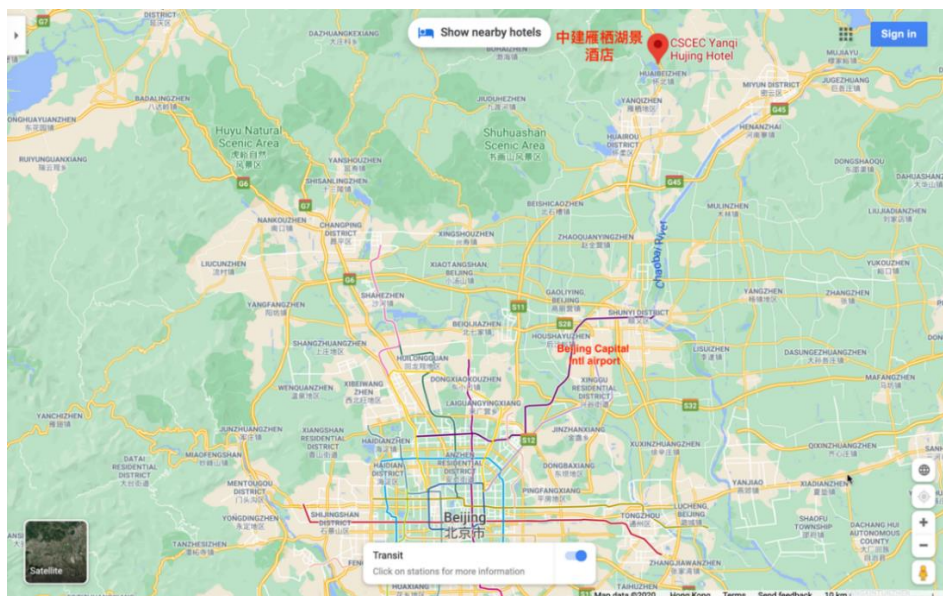

The Sino-German Agricultural Centre (DCZ) is a joint initiative of the German Federal Ministry of Food and Agriculture (BMEL) and the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs (MARA) of the People's Republic of China. The DCZ was established in March 2015 as a central contact and information office with the purpose of coordinating the bilateral cooperation between Germany and China in the agricultural and food sector. In April 2018, the project entered its 2nd phase with the present team and implementation partners Foreign Economic Cooperation Center (FECC) of MARA on the Chinese side, and IAK Agrar Consulting GmbH in a consortium with the Leibniz Institute of Agricultural Development in Transition Economies (IAMO) on the German side. The DCZ brings together stakeholders from government, industry and academia. The spectrum of the bilateral cooperation in the agricultural sector is reflected in the three components Agricultural Policy Dialogue, Agri-food Business Dialogue and Scientific Dialogue.
