The Sino-German Agricultural Centre (DCZ) is a high-level initiative of Sino-German bilateral cooperation between the German Ministry of Food and Agriculture (BMEL) and the Chinese Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs (MARA). The DCZ's objective is to promote the cooperation between China and Germany in the agriculture and food sector and to support China's sustainable agricultural development as well as dialogues on agricultural related issues of common concern for the two countries.
